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QUESTION 23 Poor now

Stress genuinely and try to avoid facetiousness at this point. Question 23 (a) explores what the informant understands by feeling "poor". If the word "poor" seems inappropriate use the alternative "very hard up".

QUESTION 24 Poverty

Stress the word "poverty". Do not explain what you think it means if you are asked. Seek from the informant his definition and write it in the box as clearly as you can.

QUESTION 25 Voting

Ask for those old enough to have voted in the last election (March 1965). We are not concerned who they voted for (although they will probably say) but would like to know if they are sufficiently involved to vote at all. Be careful to reassure people that this is confidential and as far as you are concerned non-voting is blameless—many people consider that voting is legally compulsory or morally obligatory and so voting figures are over-estimated. Try to get a clear recollection by fixing the incident (time of day, who they went with) if necessary. Stress National, not local elections.

QUESTION 26 Action on poverty

We are interested in what the informant thinks can be done. Give as full an answer as possible.

Judging from the totals to 97.822. There are 2 disabled people in this family, although the family don't really realize this. The husband (M. 3rd) is disabled by accumulation of difficulties resulting from his age, but because his general health is good, family think he is very strong. The wife is still limited by her heart condition but both of herself as much as ~~she~~ better than in the past, when she felt much more ill & also when she suffered the effect of illness, such as failure to keep jobs because of failing medical exams for pension scheme.

In section III C.W.E. could not give any very accurate information about sick pay, pensions etc. However I have seen an information booklet from Colleagues since the interview & I cannot find any reason why conditions in the booklet should not apply to C.W.E. (I queried this with him at last visit) so I have noted that the booklet says on P. 12a.
